Yellow Weather Warning ...

The Met Office have issued a yellow weather warning for Wales, stating that there is potential for very windy spells and heavy rain across the UK between 9am on Sunday 23rd September and 9am on Monday 24th September. They have provided a list of what to expect –

- There is a small chance of injuries and danger to life from flying debris.
- There is a slight chance of some damage to buildings, such as tiles blown from roofs or through falling trees and branches.
- There is a small chance of longer journey times or cancellations as road, rail, air and ferry services are affected.
- There is a slight chance that power cuts may occur, with the potential to affect other services, such as mobile phone coverage.
- There is a small chance that injuries and danger to life could occur from large waves and beach material being thrown onto sea fronts, coastal roads and properties.
