Access to school site

Following a routine visit from the Health and Safety department in BCBC there will be a change to the pedestrian entry and exit onto the school site.

From Monday 16th May pedestrians will only be able to enter and exit the school grounds via the pedestrian gate at the far corner of the school grounds (near the cycle track) between 8.15am and 9.00am and 2.50pm and 3.00pm.

The pedestrian gate at the front of the school (next to the main gate) will only be used by pupils using home to school transport and will be supervised by the Site Manager.

Dispensation may be given for specific circumstances only through prior discussion and consultation with senior leaders.

All parents and pupils are asked to use the designated footpaths when entering the school site and not cross the carpark.
