See, Say, Signpost

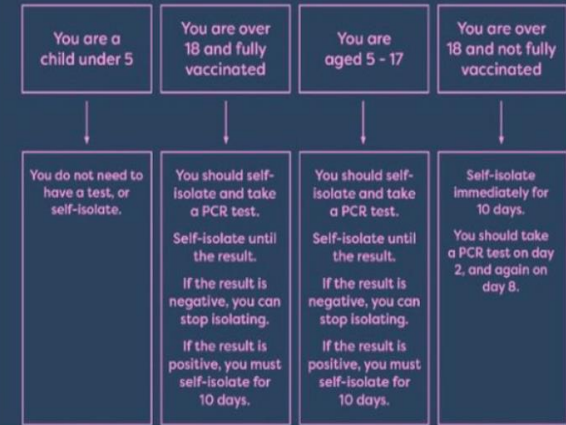
Project SPEAK - 'Suicide, Prevention, Education, Awareness and Kindness' - is a three-year, Big Lottery funded project that is providing a suicide prevention and postvention service across the Cwm Taf Morgannwg Mind footprint. The training is available to all members of the community and will support you to:

- Improve your awareness and understanding of suicide
- Learn to spot the signs in a person who is having thoughts of suicide
- Develop a range of intervention skills including having a caring conversation
- Ask the question
- Prepare a safety plan
- Signpost the person to support

The training is delivered in an informal and friendly manner, is informative and interactive. The session is approximately 2 hours and is currently delivered online on Zoom or Teams, until we are able to resume with face-to-face delivery.
